Certain majors require a limit on the number of students they can accommodate and are designated Limited Enrollment Programs (LEP).

Freshman Direct Admits (New freshmen or new transfer students from outside the University System of Maryland who begin fall 2005 or after): All students accepted directly as freshman into the BMGT major must complete a series of gateway courses and a review at 45 credits. Gateway criteria include:

- Completion of BMGT 220, 221 and 230 with a minimum grade of 2.0
- Completion of MATH 220 or 140 with a minimum grade of 2.0
- Completion of ECON 200 and 201 with a minimum grade of 2.0
- Completion of CORE* Fundamental Studies English

Students must be in the process of completing BMGT 221 and Econ 200 or 201 in the semester in which they reach 60 credits.

A minimum grade point average of 2.0 in all courses is required at the 45-credit review

Transfer Admission Requirements (external transfers only who began at a Maryland Institution fall 2005 or after): Internal and external transfer students may apply to become business majors at 60 credits. Admission is competitive and students are accepted on a space-available after completing the following criteria:

- Completion of BMGT 220, 221 and 230 or 231 (or equivalent) with a minimum grade of 2.0
- Completion of ECON 200 and 201 with a minimum grade of 2.0
- Completion of MATH 220 or 140 with a minimum grade of 2.0 or above
- Completion of CORE* Fundamental Studies English
- Completion of 50% of CORE Distributive Studies*

A minimum grade point average of 3.0 or above in all college coursework for all internal and external transfer students. Student may apply in the semester in which they reach 60 credits or after.

NOTE: Co-curricular involvement, leadership experience and honors and awards will also be considered in the admission decision. Students are strongly encouraged to submit with their applications a resume and letter detailing their accomplishments and experience.

PLEASE NOTE

- Only one “gateway” or performance review course may be repeated to earn the required grade and that course may only be repeated once.
- Students may apply only once to an LEP. Students who are directly admitted and fail to meet the performance review criteria will be dismissed from the major and may not reapply. Application for BMGT at Shady Grove and College Park constitute separate program locations.

- Students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the major.
- Any student denied admission or dismissed from the major may appeal directly to the Associate Dean of the College.
